Dear Parents,

We are beginning registration for next year's Religious Education classes. If you would like to have your child participate in this program, you may register by completing the form on the back of this letter. Please fill out the form and return it to the Religious Education Office. In addition, all grade school students must have the release form completed and returned as well in order to be released from Waldron Public School for religion class.

As our costs of offering religious education continue to rise, this year we have been forced to raise our tuition. We take great pride in keeping tuition as affordable as possible and for that reason have not had an increase for some time. **The new tuition for Religious Education is \$90.00 per student for all grades, 1st through 12th, if registration and payment are received by May 31, 2011. For registration and payments received after May 31, 2011, the cost of tuition is \$100.00 per student.** If you are absolutely unable to pay the religious education fee, please submit the registration form stating that you would like financial aid. No one will be denied Religious Education because of an inability to pay.

This year we are once again going to be making frequent use of our program website - www.mhtparish.com. The website is used to make announcements, post calendars, and display other information throughout the year.

The program website is just one way that we are trying to keep parents informed and involved in their children's religious education. Email is another tool that we use to keep parents up to date.
