Organizational Tips: During the past couple of years, many students have purchased 8-pocket or larger expandable binders. It allows them to keep all of their papers in one location – loose leaf paper, homework, papers returned, etc. This is not mandatory. Students need to find out what system works best for them. They will need to organize loose-leaf paper, notes, worksheets, homework to be turned in, and graded papers that are returned to them. Some students use two three-ring binders and pocket folders. Please work with your children as they discover a 'best fit' for their needs.
