A way of remembering a loved one (living or deceased) is through a gift, in that person's name, to Most Holy Trinity Educational Trust Fund.



History of the Educational Trust Fund (ETF):

The Most Holy Trinity ETF was established on May 24, 1983 to provide a solid financial base for all educational programs within the parish. All income earned on the corpus of the trust, as well as up to 20% of all new donations, are available for use in furthering educational programs in our parish. A total of \$1,736,908.00 has been disbursed to the parish since 1986.
