



Music Ministry

The High School Choir will sing next on Sunday, February 25th at 10:30am mass. If you are a high school student who would like to join us, please meet in the choir loft at 9:45am. We would LOVE to see more students in this choir! Don't be shy!

With Lent beginning, you will notice some changes happen musically during mass. Because Lent is a more somber liturgical season, musical instruments will be played only to support singing, which lends itself to more periods of silence during mass. In addition, during Lent we no longer sing an Alleluia, but will instead switch to a Gospel Acclamation at that point in mass. Finally, we will be switching to the same mass parts we used during Advent, but we will use the Latin lyrics instead of the English. This is the same Latin setting we have used in years past during Lent. Please consider these musical changes a way to help you better enter into the Lenten season.
