From the Pastor's Desk

Sacred Paschal Triduum

Please take note of the Holy Week liturgy schedule found on page 3 of this bulletin. If you have never experienced the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum ("three days") before, I highly encourage you to attend the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday at 7:00pm, with "the Nightwatch" (adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Youth Center) until 11:00pm. On Friday, we will have Stations of the Cross at noon, and the solemn liturgy on Good Friday of the Lord's Passion at 3:00pm. Good Friday is the only day in the year when throughout the whole world, no Mass is ever said. Also, as a reminder, there are **no confessions on Good Friday or Holy Saturday**. Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat, in honor of the sacred flesh of the Lord that truly died on the Cross for our sins. **The parish office will be closed on Good Friday**. The Triduum concludes with the Vigil in the Holy Night of Easter on Holy Saturday at 8:30pm, at which time the *Alleluia* returns and our Easter celebrations of the Resurrection of the Lord finally begin!

I would especially encourage those who may be traveling for spring break to try to keep a prayerful recollection during these holy days. You can find a local parish wherever you may be at the website masstimes.org

Good Friday Holy Land Collection

The Catholic Church throughout the world takes up a special collection each Good Friday to assist our brothers and sisters in the Holy Land. Sadly, we know that the past few years have been even more difficult than usual for them, marked by war and violence. Cardinal Claudio Gugerotti, Prefect of the Dicastery for Eastern Churches, recently wrote: "To live, our brothers and sisters also need your contribution. Many Christians in the Holy Land have lost everything, including the work that depended on the presence of pilgrims - who now, almost without exception, are afraid to return. The faithful who remain in the Holy Places know that through your support - and sometimes only through it - even if security cannot yet be guaranteed, schools can reopen, new homes can be built, and care can be provided where destruction has been total." Thank you for your generosity.

Holy Spirit Encounter—Faith Like a Child

"We've been doing prayer sheets in class for a while, and I've really grown in sharing God's word with others. I used to feel anxious and afraid to pray for people. At first, I wondered if the words I wrote were just my own thoughts or really from the Lord. But over time, I've learned how to recognize His voice. Now I have more confidence because His voice comes more clear to my mind." ~ MHT middle school student

Over the past several years, our middle school students have been growing in their ability to listen for the Lord's voice and share His encouragement with others through prayer. One simple way they have practiced this is through "prayer sheets"—writing down words of encouragement they feel God placing on their hearts for someone else.

For many of our students, this has meant stepping into something new and sometimes a little uncomfortable—but also something really amazing. They're learning that even small steps of courage can open the door for the Lord to speak in meaningful and personal ways, both for them and for the people they are praying for.

"A little while ago, I gave a prayer sheet to one of my coaches. When I handed it to her, she started to tear up and hugged me. A few days later, she told me she keeps it in her pocket all the time and that she really needed those words right then. It made her so happy—and it made me happy too—because I realized I had taken a risk and been a vessel for the Lord." ~ MHT middle school student

We would love to invite you to come experience this for yourself! At our upcoming prayer event, our middle school students will be serving on prayer teams supported by trained adults, offering short, encouraging prayers and words they feel the Lord may be sharing for you. Whether this feels familiar or completely new, we invite you to come with an open heart—expecting that the Lord desires to meet you, encourage you, and remind you just how seen and loved you are!
