#### Congratulations!

#### **Growing in our Eucharistic Devotion**

As we consider how we can grow in our devotion to the real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, today we consider how we receive Holy Communion. Great care should always be taken with the Blessed Sacrament. Sadly, I once found a host on the floor of an elevator at a hospital and another time in a hymnal. Sometimes people have come forward to receive Communion while chewing gum. I've seen the host fall and the precious blood spilled on the floor on a number of occasions. These may not have been intentional and we all understand accidents do happen, but they highlight why it is important to be ever mindful of the Lord whom we receive in Holy Communion.

So just a few thoughts on other situations that sometimes arise. First, when we receive Holy Communion, we don't need to be in a hurry. Please be mindful that someone may be going to the Communion station on the side of you. Adults who are holding little ones might consider receiving on the tongue, as it can be difficult to reverently consume the sacred host with just one hand. We never judge anyone who is not receiving Holy Communion. Indeed, it is to the credit of those not receiving for taking time to discern their reception. Lastly, sometimes people come forward in the Communion line who are genuinely confused about what to do and are clearly not prepared to receive Holy Communion, so it would be better in such circumstances for them to receive a blessing instead. If you invite a guest to Mass who is not Catholic or doesn't practice, this is an opportunity to have a gentle and loving conversation with them about our belief in the real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, and the practices and obligations that flow from this belief.


